

READING GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. A recurring theme in *A Debt Too Deep* is secrecy and hiding one's past and/or true self. How many of the book's characters keep secrets, and which character held the secret with the most potential for destruction?
2. Another theme in the book is forgiveness/unforgiveness. How do the main characters Vince and Leandra display both in different areas of their lives?
3. Do you think Vince would have handled the situation differently in the end if no reporter (i.e., threat of public exposure) had been involved?
4. Recall Leandra's stance toward God throughout most of the story. Have you ever been (or admitted to yourself that you were) angry at God for not preventing a tragic situation or for not solving a problem that you created?
5. How many of the things on your list of "things I would change if I could do it all over again" have actually worked out for your good/led you to a place of greater spiritual maturity? Would you still change them?
